

## TOG Pre-Rhetoric Literature assignments due at Co-Op 8 on Dec. 8

Please carefully read the entire instructions before starting the assignment.  
The questions below are to be answered over the course of the next two weeks as students read *Poetry for Young People: William Shakespeare*.

### ***The first week***

1. In *Poetry for Young People: William Shakespeare* read the Introduction and Sonnets 18, 116 and 29. You'll need to read each sonnet multiple times as you follow the instructions at the top of the Literature SAP (Page 18 of Week 16). **Read the instructions on the SAP before reading the sonnets.**
2. Complete Literature SAP (Page 18 of Week 16).
3. Memorize the first seven literary definitions on sheet given out in class.
4. Practice the Shakespeare lines you've been assigned for the Unit Celebration.

### ***The following week***

1. In *Poetry for Young People: William Shakespeare* read the remaining sections that were not previously assigned.
2. Complete Literature SAP (Page 18 of Week 17)
3. Memorize the remaining six literary definitions on sheet given out in class
4. Practice the Shakespeare lines you've been assigned for the Unit Celebration. Be prepared to present some of those lines in class to practice your oral presentation skills.
