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This calendar is meant to help the coop “stay on the same page” as best we can, which will in turn help our families to individually plan better at home. In other words, we try not to have too much variation between what the rhetoric students and grammar level students are expected to prepare for - otherwise, your home study can become tricky. It would also defeat one of the benefits of using Tapestry... being in the same time frame and generally the same topics. It should be noted, however, that your class syllabi are the ‘master’ of what is required for your students to prepare for.

The following is an explanation of the calendar. Please contact Michelle Piscatello, if you need further clarification.

**Revision # / TOG Y3 / 2017-18**— please be sure you always have the most current revision

**Month / Day** — This is the Thursday (coop day) date

**Coop #** — We will have 16 coops again this year  
“OFF” weeks — These are at your discretion.

**“Responsible for Material up through TOG Week...”** — This is where we try to stay on the same page. If your student has completed work through the curriculum week listed, they should be “on track” with the others in the coop. Please note that your student’s individual class syllabus takes precedents over this schedule. Also, due to the dates of our coop and a commitment to try to not ask you to “squeeze” more than one week per quarter, the topics for the last the last quarter, specifically, do not combine as well. For example : weeks 28, 29, 30 combine well, 31 & 32, 33 & 34, etc.

**Our Home’s Plan** — YAY! You are still in control! Please use this column to plan out your year. You can adjust for when you take vacations or when you think the topics are lighter and you want to squeeze more in.

**The Straight Through Plan** — If you were to only do one Tapestry curriculum week per week, starting at the Hardin County School start date, this is a sample schedule to help you see how to finish by May 24.

As you can see FOR UNITS 1 AND 2 you would

- \* *choose one week off - either fall break or Thanksgiving week - or split it,*
- \* *do school from Aug 10-Dec 21,*
- \* *not get to week 18 prior to coop #8*

FOR UNITS 3 AND 4 you would

- \* *start back Jan 4 and end on May 17, (end date could be extended by one week, if two weeks are taken off this semester)*

**The “Need it Faster Plan”** — This plan is one way the curriculum can be “shortened”.

Note: Older students tend to have less reading and questions towards the end of a unit as they are expected to review for a test, etc. However, younger students often have widely varying topics or cultural explorations at these times. Look ahead to evaluate pulling some of these younger topics into other weeks over two to three weeks so that you don’t “miss them”.

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**Unit Celebration Dates & Notes** — Our three **unit celebrations** typically fall in Oct, Jan, and April. As the dates are finalized, add them to your calendar in this column.

Also, around Valentine's Day, we often have a **Parents Evening** (dinner) to get to know the spouses better. Date for this will typically be set in January.

**TeenPact** falls later this year due to a longer legislative session. Unfortunately, it will be quite the trick for Rhetoric students to get their 2 weeks of work done in 4 business days, but that is why you know about the dates ahead of time! I am certain the Rhetoric teachers will be taking this into account as well.

Finally, Notations for HCS Fall and Spring Break are listed as well as holidays.
