Literature Assignment

- Read *Swiss Family Robinson*. At the end of *each* chapter, write 1-3 **complete** sentences summarizing what happened in that chapter. Keep all of these together so you'll have a complete summary of the book. Turn this summary in at Co-op #4.
- Think about the conflict in *Swiss Family Robinson*. Is the primary source of conflict external or internal? If external, which type of conflict is it? Review the definitions of external conflict and internal conflict on your sheet of literary terms in order to be prepared to discuss this in class.
- Memorize the definitions for **Mood**, **Narrator**, **Allusion** and **Imagery**. Be sure to continue to review the previous definitions that you've memorized since they are all quiz-able in class. Use the quizlet.com link I sent by e-mail to keep these definitions fresh in your mind.

Geography Assignment

- For the first three days, each day use a dry erase pen to label all of the South American countries and their capitals. Learn to spell the countries correctly. For the second week, practice blobbing South America and labeling the countries and capitals. At our next co-op students will be asked to blob and label South America from memory. Don't forget to pay special attention to the location of the Equator in relation to South America.
