

Dialectic Literature for Co-op 7

Students should read *The Princess and The Goblin* in its entirety before Co-op 7. Reading over Thanksgiving break may be required in order to finish the book and assignment prior to the next co-op, although parts A & B of each question can be completed prior to finishing the reading. We will discuss the allegorical aspects of this story in class using the guided discussion on pages 47-49 of the Week 16 Teacher's Notes.

Memorize: oxymoron, allegory, protagonist, antagonist and characters from your literary terms.

Allegory: a story that has a deeper meaning than may be understood on the surface.

Questions for *The Princess and the Goblin*

The questions below do **NOT** need to be answered in complete sentences, although the scriptures should be copied and pasted in full.

Geography for Co-op #7

Sketch an outline of the United States, then sketch and label the states on the Pacific coast and the southern border states. Washington, Oregon, California, Arizona, New Mexico, Texas, Louisiana, Mississippi, Alabama, Georgia and Florida. The goal is not just to label the states correctly, but to be able to draw/blob the states properly in relation to each other.
