3. Identify at least three mentions or evidence of the supernatural or religion in the story. Note the wording that infers the supernatural or religion, as well as the chapter number.

It may be correct or incorrect, biblical or unbiblical, depending on what the person believes about God, the created world, himself, etc. What can you infer from Doyle's worldview based on his references to the supernatural and/or religion?
