The art, literature, music, and architecture created during any time period is directly connected to the philosophies and theology of the era. The arts are both influenced by the times and contributors to the times.

During our 8 class periods, we will talk about art, music, and architecture of the Middle Ages, the Renaissance & Reformation, the Baroque period, and the beginnings of the NeoClassical era.

There will be homework: light reading, studying pictures, and listening to music and composer biographies.

Pre-Rhetoric & Rhetoric students will do a Shakespeare project mid year.

Pre-Rhetoric will also do a writing or poster project on an artist, composer, or architect during the year.)
