- April 1940 Germany invades Norway and Denmark
- May 1940 Germany invades Belgium and Holland
- June 12, 1940 France signs armistice with Germany
- July 10, 1940-Sept. 17, 1941 The Battle of Britain is fought
- June 1941 Hitler invades USSR
- Dec. 7, 1941 Japanese attack Pearl Harbor
- Dec. 8, 1941 US declares war on Japan, entering WWII
- Feb. 2, 1943 Germans surrender to Soviets at Stalingrad
- July 1943 German officers attempt to assassinate Hitler
- June 6, 1944 Allied troops land in Normandy on D-Day.
- Feb. 1945 FDR, Churchill, and Stalin meet at Yalta
- April 12, 1945 Pres. Roosevelt dies
- 1945 – 1953 Harry Truman is President
- April 16, 1945 Soviet army surrounds Berlin
- April 30, 1945 Hitler commits suicide
- May 8, 1945 Victory in Europe (V-E Day)
- Aug. 6, 1945 Atomic bomb dropped on Hiroshima
- Aug. 9, 1945 Atomic bomb dropped on Nagasaki
- Aug. 15, 1945 Japan announces surrender (V-J Day)
