4. Why do you think Corrie chose to help the Jewish people even though doing so put her in danger?
5. How do Corrie and Betsie respond when faced with evil?
6. How did Betsie's life influence Corrie?
7. What did Corrie do after her release? Why do you think she chose to do this instead of living a quiet life?
8. How have you been inspired by Corrie's life and testimony?
