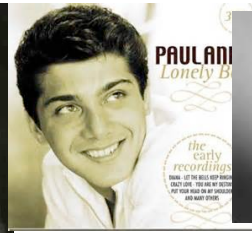
### Mainstream Popular Music

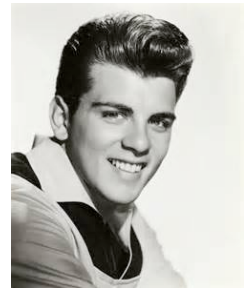

## **Birth of Rock n Roll**

“Rebellious” music - attractive to young people who wanted an alternative to musical tastes of adult world

Pioneers in music - looking for a new sound

Within a decade (mid 1960s) Rock n Roll dominated the music industry

ROOTS: country/western blended with blues

1954 “Shake Rattle and Roll” released by Joe Turner - a little racey

Rereleased and cleaned up - Bill Haley and the Comets

Most early rock was first written and recorded by black artists - then later covered by white artists - reaching a broader audience.

Controversy -loud

- rebellious or sexual lyrics

- opponents said it was corrupting young people

- inspiring wilder dancing

Most traditional record labels (RCA, Columbia) stuck with mainstream artists music at first. New labels were created to accommodate the new music (Sun, Atlantic)

SUN RECORDS: Sam Phillips, a radio announcer, opened a recording studio in Memphis. 1st rock song recorded was “Rocket 88” by Jackie Brenston (about a car) He mostly worked with black recording artists and groups at first. Then he began looking for a white singer who had sound and feeling of a black performer . . .

ELVIS PRESLEY

1954-55 Elvis - still a teenager - made 1st records. R & B on one side/country on the other.

By the end of 1956 - Elvis was a national star.
