

## Pre-Rhetoric Assignments for Co-op 3

We will use the next two weeks to read *Canterbury Tales* in preparation for Co-op 3. Please note that our literature assignments are one week ahead of our other TOG work, so the *Canterbury Tales* assignments and SAPs will be found in Weeks 6 and 7.

- Make corrections to SAP 4 & 5 that you received back after Co-op #2. Bring to next co-op for full credit of your work.
- Read p. 7-45 of *Canterbury Tales* translated by Barbara Cohen\*
- Answer the questions on SAP #6 (P. 22 of Week 6) in complete sentences on a separate sheet of paper. Questions 5-8 should be answered with at least a paragraph. Be sure to write out the Scriptures and references in response to the quotes listed in #6 & #7, as well as why the scripture refutes or supports the quote.
- Memorize the definition of satire and irony.
- Read p. 46-end of *Canterbury Tales* translated by Barbara Cohen\*
- Complete SAP #7 (P. 18 of Week 7).
- Describe how “The Wife of Bath’s Tale” displays irony.
- Review definitions of literary terms you’ve been assigned to memorized (Week 1 to present)
