TIMELINE EVENTS: Print the timeline pages provided. If this is your first year in Rhetoric please pay attention to the in colors used for each event. It is important you use the proper colors. Print these sheets on cardstock or heavy paper.

IN RED INK: **325**-Council of Nicaea; **306-337**-Reign of Constantine; **312**-Constantine adopts Christianity; **440**-Leo I is Bishop of Rome; **453**-Attila the Hun dies; **476**-Fall of Western Roman Empire

IN RED INK CIRCLED IN ORANGE: **527**-Reign of Justinian I; **533**-Byzantine armies defeat Vandals in Africa

IN ORANGE INK: **570**-Mohammad Born; **622**-The Hegira (Mohammad flees from Mecca to Medina); **630**-Muslims occupy Mecca; **750**-Muslim Empire at its peak

IN ORANGE INK CIRCLED IN RED: **732**-Charles Martel stops Muslim Invasion of Europe at the Battle of Tours

MAPS: Print the base map provided. On it, shade the following (I recommend doing so lightly in colored pencil): In orange shade the regions under Muslim control at the time of Muhammad's death(632 AD) In Pink shade the Muslim Empire at its height (750 AD).

Label the following in INK or FINE TIP marker: **Baghdad, Jerusalem, Mecca, Medina, Arabia**
